**Snippet, Confetti Background**  
Come play with fabric and learn my technique for making this highly textured background.

#### Supply List:

- 1 Fat Quarter foundation fabric in your chosen dominant color of your background (this is going to covered up- great way to use up fabric in your stash.)
- 1 Fat Quarter quilt back
- 1 Fat Quarter batting
- 3/4 yard “Wonder Under” or “MistyFuse” Fusible web. (Bring pressing cloth or teflon sheet if you use Misty Fuse).
- A variety of **batik fabrics** (at least 25) in 3” strips that equal 1-1/2 yards of fabric from your stash. (To select batiks, choose one batik with multiple colors as your inspiration fabric and then pull additional batiks with complementary colors from your stash to build your confetti).
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- 1 Zip-lock bag (Gallon size)

#### **Unmarked Free Motion Quilting on a Domestic / Sitdown Machine**

The goal of this class is to have fun and get the students comfortable moving fabric under the needle. We work on strategies to give the best stitch quality including thread choices, needles, tension, thread delivery systems, and machine setup.

Students will be introduced to a minimum of 6 all over quilting designs to get started with free motion quilting.

#### Supply List:

- Sewing machine in good working order, cleaned and ready to go. Also, please bring the Instruction book for your machine.
- Screwdriver to adjust bobbin tension if applicable.

- Size 80 Topstitch sewing machine needle.
- Free-Motion Quilting Foot specific for your machine.
- Small Sewing Scissors.
- 2 empty bobbins
- 1/2 yard of 72" polyester Felt (any Color)
- Hand Sewing Needle (For weaving in thread tails)
- Thread: One 50 Wt. cotton (for bobbin) and one 40 wt. Polyester (for top of machine) in contrasting colors.
