Discover the quilt designer and home decorator in YOU! This is a design class that will give you the confidence to create your own original designs. Make a seasonal room accent, or the perfect gift for that upcoming anniversary or housewarming!

First, using a classic quilt block as an inspiration, you will “stretch” or skew it to design an original table runner or skinny quilt. I'll help you choose the perfect mix of fabrics for your design and customize it to fit your table, color scheme, room style.



Supply List:

I recommend pre-shrinking fabric.

- 1 yard of a multi-color focal fabric you love to use for large patches, spacers, borders or backing.
- 1/4 yard or fat quarter each of subtly textured prints such as tone-on-tone, variegated/mottled, vines, geometrics, abstracts - in colors to match your multi-color focal fabric. Make sure you have light, medium, and dark values, plus striped fabric. Bring extra fabric options and choices.
- Fusible web (for appliqué, if desired)

Tools and Supplies:

- 2 pencils with erasers
- Graph paper
- Freezer paper
- Cutting mat
- Small (4" or 6" square) and large (6" x 24") acrylic rulers
- 45mm rotary cutter
- Scissors
- Sewing machine in good working order
- Neutral-colored sewing thread
- Plastic baggies for taking patches home.
