

Barb Vedder “Circle Play” workshop April 15, 2023

A fun workshop that teaches quilters how to make perfect circles which are used in so many popular quilts. This is a sewing machine class where students will learn the technique of finished edge machine appliqué using a lollipop pattern for a mini, runner or wallhanging. I will teach an easy method for making stems and tips for making a scrappy string border. This class is great for all skill levels.

Supply List:

- Sewing Machine – with **all cords**
- Open Foot attachment (if you have one)
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Ruler for cutting at least 3” x 6”
- Basic sewing supplies, sharp scissors, needle and seam ripper
- Spray starch
- White School Glue with fine tip (I have 1 oz. bottles for sale - \$5.00)
- Pencil and Notepaper (for notes)
- Thread for basting & topstitching (bring a variety)
- Extra lighting - optional

Fabrics For Small Wall Hanging:

- 18” x 22” (FQ) piece for background (light or medium works best)
- 18” x 22” (FQ) for flower stems
- ¼ Yard for binding
- Scraps in all sizes for the string border and circles from 3” to 7” square

Fabrics For Table Runner:

- 20”x36” or ¾ yard piece for the background (light or medium works best)
- 18” x 22” (FQ) for the flower stems
- 1/4 yard for the outer border and binding
- Scraps & strips in all sizes for string border & circles from 3” and larger.

Fabrics for Large Wall Hanging:

- 1 yard for the background (light or medium works best)
- 18” x 22” (FQ) for the flower stems
- ½ yard for the inner borders and binding
- Scraps in all sizes for the string border and circles from 3” to 7” square
