

## GVQC Mystery Quilt 2021

This quilt can be scrappy, or planned. If you want it very planned, use the yardages in parentheses.

### Fabrics:

1 fat quarter very light

1 fat quarter very dark

5 – 6 fat quarters lightish (or 1 ½ yards)

5 – 6 fat quarters darkish (or 1 ½ yards)

Or enough fabric from your stash to about equal the amounts above

### Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working order with ¼” foot and manual

Foot pedal for your machine – don’t forget it!

Extension cord (not needed at Jackie Lynn’s)

Rotary cutter and mat

Rulers: You need four! Two square ones, two rectangular

6 **or** 6 ½” square, 12 ½” square, 6 x 12 and 6 x 18 **or** 6 x 24

Basic sewing supplies

Small wooden pressing bar, if you have one. Thumbnails work, too! We will be pressing all the time – to often to be jumping up and down for the irons. We’ll use irons only for final block pressing.
