

Chris Wickert: Advanced Applique

In this appliqué class students will use either silk or cotton fabrics to make any of the blocks featured in Deborah Kemball's pattern pack entitled *Floral Abundance Quilt*.

Supply List:

- a copy of *Floral Abundance Quilt* by Deborah Kemball (available from Amazon both as paperback and Kindle editions). Please purchase in plenty of time before the class so that you can study the blocks and decide which one(s) you want to make.
- enough silk or cotton fabric for the block(s) you plan to make. If you plan to use silk, contact Chris about silk sources.
- 100 weight silk thread- colors to match your appliqué
- appliqué needles
- freezer paper
- a 12" X 18" piece of parchment paper
- small craft iron
- portable iron surface (as firm as possible)
- small fabric scissors (preferably serrated)
- paper scissors
- fine line water erasable marker
- sharp pencil (preferably a mechanical one)
- liquid glue baste (like Roxanne's) if you are appliquéing with cotton
- Karen Kay Buckley's "Perfect Circles" (optional)
