So many quilters use just one method to mark a quilt for quilting. When that method won't work, they are stumped and as a result, the quilting and finishing of the quilt suffers. This class will cover a myriad of methods for marking that will solve almost any marking dilemma.

Supply list:

It will be helpful to bring some fat quarters to mark up. Besides a plain muslin, bring some busy prints, dark fabrics or orphan blocks as well.

A block stencil will be helpful to have.

If you have a blue marking pen, please bring it.

If you have a white marking pen, bring that too.

Tape to hold your fabric to a table

If you have a portable light box, it will be helpful to have, and share.

There will be a small supply charge for this class. I will provide some seldom used but very helpful items for participants to learn to use.

If participants would like to purchase my favorite pens I can have some available for sale if I'm told in advance. With the pandemic, supplies are often on backorder so I need a little lead time to obtain them.
