Supply List

Fat quarters: one of each fabric in your color palette. If a fabric will be used in multiple spike arcs, bring two fat quarters. The center medallion of the sample quilt uses one fat quarter each of 9 colors and two fat quarters of the dark teal, which is used in three spike arcs.

Hera Marker or equivalent to crease lines on the freezer paper without tearing it.

Wonder Tape if you have it. It will be available for you to try.

Add-a-Quarter ruler if you have it. A 6 1/2" by 24 1/2" quilters ruler is fine.

Freezer paper to design your own blocks.

Scissors to cut paper and fabric.

Painters tape.

Pencil and eraser.

Basic sewing supplies: Sewing machine with feet and power cords, thread, sewing machine needles, etc.

\$4.00 materials fee, payable to the instructor, covers pre-printed freezer paper patterns to make all four New York Beauty blocks in the center medallion of the sample quilt.
